OLD VINES

50-year-old Carignan

- **Producer:** Claude Vialade
- **Appellation:** IGP Côtes Catalanes
- **Origin:** Occitania



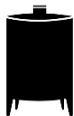
Varietal range: 100% Carignan



Soil types: The vines are located on weathered schist soils in the foothills of the Pyrenees overlooking the Roussillon plain. The climate is mitigated by mild Mediterranean weather but also marked by the strong prevailing Tramontane wind and outstanding sunshine levels.



Vineyard management: The vines grow in characteristic terraced vineyards. These old-vine Carignans are trained as bush vines and the fruit is picked by hand.



Winemaking: The fruit is hand-picked, destemmed, crushed and then put into tanks. Traditional maceration methods are used with particular attention paid to temperatures. Pumping over is used at the start of fermentation and rack-and-return during the second phase, which brings greater concentration to the wine.



Tasting notes: The wine displays an intense black hue with purple tints. The nose is powerful and driven by jammy black berry fruit notes and spices. The palate is concentrated and soft. Serving temperature: between 16 and 18°C.



Food pairings: This wine can be enjoyed throughout the meal and pairs with local cold meats, meats in a sauce and soft cheeses.
